

What is VirTra's Master Class?

The VirTra Master Class is a two-day onsite training course aimed at enhancing the skills of VirTra simulator instructors and operators. The approach emphasizes maximizing training time, ensuring consistency, and leveraging the strengths of the VirTra training system.



A substantial portion of this instructor-led training involves students creating and running practice events, with the instructor available for guidance and evaluation. The course places a strong emphasis on debriefs conducted by both the class and instructor to foster the development of advanced training skills.

It is recommended that attendees have 60 - 90 days of experience operating their VirTra simulator, as this class is deep and rich with information and teaches advanced use of the system for those who have already grasped the basics

- Estimated Time 16 hours
- Class Size Designed for pairs of officers with a maximum class size of 6 (3 pairs). If the
 class size is smaller than 6 (3 pairs), scenarios can be cycled through.
- Class Objectives This course is designed to expand the skills of VirTra simulator instructors/operators.

The following training program and lesson plan is designed to be used with the VirTra simulator. Whereas many of the techniques have been used in law enforcement throughout the years, this training plan maximizes training time, provides consistency, and leverages the strengths of the VirTra training system.

While the course will be instructor led, a significant amount of the training will be the students creating and running training events for practice. The instructor will be available to help and evaluate the training that is created by the class. Debriefs by the class and instructor will help develop the advanced training skills

• Equipment Needed – The following list of equipment should be available to the instructor and class throughout the training program.

Customer's responsibility to have working and available. Any technical/support issues must be coordinated with VirTra and worked out prior to class. Upon scheduling a class, Service and Support will reach out to the customer for a maintenance check.

- Laptop, projector/monitor, and speakers for PowerPoint presentation
- VirTra simulator
- Handguns (minimum of 2)
- Recoil kits for handgun and rifle (minimum of 2 for each firearm)
- Taser® (minimum of 2)
- Threat fire

- Rifle (minimum of 2)
- VirTra Taser® cartridges (minimum of 4)
- Low-light flashlight

This course will take place at the agency's simulator location and be led by experienced VirTra professionals.
